The Director facilitates communication between all departments, sharing this with the Infection Control Committee, the Environment of Care/Safety Committee, both of which are managed by the Infection Control leader and with Administration. In conjunction with Infection Prevention Department and Plant Operations, they assure that effective measures are developed to prevent, identify, and control safety hazards. They coordinate the services through leadership and collaboration with colleagues throughout the Medical Center. The Director is responsible for carrying out assignments in a manner to assure success in financial management, human resources management, leadership, quality, and operational management objectives. The Director participates in program development and facility-wide performance improvement.
