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ABOHN Practice Analysis Update

Exam development is continuous work. The development of a certification exam begins with a Job/Practice Analysis. The purpose of a practice analysis study is to describe the job activities of occupational health nurses in sufficient detail in order to provide a basis for the continued development of a professional, job-related, evidence-based certification examination.



PAAC-February 2023

Volunteers from our certified OHNs formed the ABOHN 2023 Practice Analysis Advisory Committee (PAAC). The PAAC met in person at the PSI (our testing vendor) headquarters in Olathe, KS, in February 2023 to being creating a survey which forms the basis of the exam "blueprints".

Starting with a review of our current exam specifications (2018), the PAAC developed a survey instrument which was sent to OHNs (both certified and non-certified) in April 2023. This important tool asked the survey responders to answer many detailed questions pertaining to the roles and responsibilities of OHNs across multiple industries.

The Practice Analysis survey was open for 6 weeks. The PAAC met again in May 2023 and the survey results were analyzed by the committee to understand if the OHN field had major/minor changes since the last practice analysis. As the details of the overall practice emerged from the study, this work established the purpose and intended population for the exam and defined the knowledge, skills, abilities, and other personal characteristics (KSAOs) essential for the certification designation. These KSAOs are the foundational steps in test development and provide clear links between the content of the job and the content of the assessment. The job/practice analysis helps to ensure job relevance, validity, and legal defensibility for a certification program.

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ABOHN Examination Development Updates

PHASE ONE:

The Exam Development Advisory Committee (EDAC) works year round developing test questions, creating new test forms, and analyzing the results of each test form once is has been retired. This analysis is used to equate the new test forms to the previous test forms for fair and valid testing outcomes.

This first phase of exam development is critical to analyze the needs of each program.

COHN, COHN-S and CM Item Review (Virtual and/or independent work)

Item Writing Training January 17, 2023

All EDAC members went through robust training, learning how

All EDAC members were assigned specific questions to review. These items are already in use, or in our item "bank". The EDAC members reviewed each item for accuracy and fit—to the scope of practice.

Virtual Review Meetings

Virtual review meetings were held to discuss the findings from the item writing assignment.

PHASE TWO:

After review of induvial items, the EDAC was tasked to review the current examination that are in use. The EDAC works with PSI's Psychometrician to analyze the pass/fail scores and drill down to extract information on how each individual item is testing. Each year, the EDAC constructs new test forms which equate to the retired test forms
