Position Description:	<p>This position directly supports the Port Wentworth Mill, a 24/7 manufacturing operation. Normal working hours are Monday–Friday, 7:00 AM–3:30 PM, with occasional after-hours/weekend calls. During the annual mill outage, this role may work 12-hour shifts for approximately two weeks.</p> <p>The Occupational Nurse will report to the Mill Health & Safety Manager and Corporate Nurse and provide direct medical care, first aid, injury assessment, and wellness support to employees and mill personnel. This role manages occupational health programs, medical surveillance, workers’ compensation case coordination, return-to-work processes, and confidential employee medical records.</p> <p>Key responsibilities include supporting the Emergency Response Team, coordinating care with physicians, workers’ compensation adjusters and case managers, administering drug screens and required physicals, maintaining medical supplies and equipment, and assisting with accident analysis and health-related safety recommendations. The nurse will also support training and programs related to CPR/First Aid/AED, Bloodborne Pathogens, Heat Stress, Respiratory Protection, Hearing Conservation, vaccinations, wellness initiatives, blood drives, and annual health fairs.</p> <p>The successful candidate must have a current unrestricted nursing license in Georgia. A bachelor’s degree in nursing with at least three years of occupational health nursing experience is preferred. Manufacturing experience is strongly desired. Preferred certifications include Certified Occupational Health Nurse, Certified Occupational Hearing Conservationist, Case Management, ACLS, and American Heart Association CPR/First Aid/AED instructor certification. Knowledge of OSHA regulations, occupational medicine, critical care, workers’ compensation, and health/safety program management is highly preferred.</p> <p>We are seeking a collaborative, approachable nursing professional with strong communication, organization, problem-solving, and case management skills who can support employee health, safety, and wellness in a fast-paced industrial environment.</p>
